ROTARY PROJECTS

Donation to Community Programs

Sylva Rotary donates between \$8,000 and \$25,000 annually to community and non-profit agencies in need. The contributions help these non-profits and community programs sustain services to the Jackson County Community.

District Grants

Each year the club sponsors community projects with assistance from Rotary District Grants. Some of the past projects include: 4 Way Test Program with Jackson County Schools, Bike Fixation Station, Ramps for Elderly, Free Dental Clinic, and more.

International Projects

Sylva Rotary Club participates in International Projects each year such as: Rotarians Against Hunger, Wheelchair Foundations, Bridges to Prosperity, Panama Project, Polio Plus, Friendship Exchange, etc.

Jackson County Schools

Through the generosity of the W.C. Hennessee Foundation, Jack and Carol Hennessee, the Cashiers and Sylva Rotary Clubs, N.C. Surveyors Association, and the local community, over \$24,000 has been contributed to provide a walking trail and other improvements at the Jackson County Community School.

Rotary Island

A beautification project by the Sylva Rotary Club for traffic coming in and out of Cullowhee and Sylva through Hwy 107. Each month the Club trims, weeds, and cleans the traffic island. Season flowers and shrubs are also planted as a part of this project.

Students of the Month

During their school terms, the Rotary Club recognizes Students of the Month from Smoky Mountain High School and Southwestern Community College.

Backpack Meals

The Rotary Club provides backpack meals to the students at the Jackson Community School so that students will have meals for the weekend.

Dr. Charles McConnell Endowed Scholarship

The Sylva Rotary Club is involved in raising over \$15,000 for an endowed scholarship at Southwestern Community College as a memorial to Dr. Charles McConnell, a longtime member of the Sylva Rotary Club.
