

35th Annual Cape Fear Rotary Golf Tournament

Friday, May 30th, 2025 - 9:00 AM Shotgun Start River Landing Country Club, Wallace, NC

Rules

1. Golf professionals are not permitted to play. Men will play from the designated sponsored tee box markers. Seniors 65+ can play from the senior tees except when competing for the hole in one prize. Ladies from ladies' tees except when competing for hole in one prize.

2. Two putt maximum once on the green. After your team misses the first putt, pick it up and move on to the next hole.

3. Pace of play will be monitored. If you fall a hole behind, pick up the pace to close the gap.

4. No handicap restrictions apply.

5. The first ball in the hole is the recorded score.

6. USGA rules will govern all play. Rules shall be enforced by the other teams in your group. The Cape Fear National Pro and the Tournament Committee will interpret the rules and decide any questions in dispute concerning scoring and play. The Tournament Committee and the golf Pro also reserve the right to make any changes regarding weather delay or postponement.

7. In the rough, hazard or bunker, the original ball must be played first, as it lies and the other players may place their balls within one club length of the original ball's position.

8. Winter rules will be in effect. Players may improve their lie by moving their ball one club length, but not closer to the hole.

9. Mulligans are for sale. Each player is allowed to purchase one mulligan but must declare before using them during play. Mulligans cannot be used to win hole-in-one prizes, closest to pins, or longest drive prizes.

10. Golf carts are to be kept away from greens and tees.

11. Repair all ball marks.

12. One player from each team shall act as captain and is responsible for turning in scorecards to the Golf Pro at the completion of the round.

13. In case of a tie, playoffs will be on the card starting at the #1 handicap hole, then #2 handicap, etc. (Example: If 2 teams are tied at the #11 position, the winner of the playoff will finish at the #11 position and the next team will be at #12)

14. After all scores are turned in, the teams will be flight into four flights with 10 teams per flight. Prizes will be awarded to the first, second and third place teams in each flight.
