What does your Club have planned for World Interact Week. The dates are November 1 through November 7, 2021. Be sure to let us know what you do to celebrate.



By direction of the Rotary District Governor, Dr. Vince Costa and agreed to by your Interact District Governor, Connor Herrington, MASKS WILL BE MANDATORY while inside the Greensburg Country Club in all common areas.
